<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Corrugated cardboard boxes (for shipping, grocery, liquor store, moving boxes) ✓ Carrier trays (for bulk bottled water, cans, food, etc) ✓ Pizza boxes (clean) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove any plastic, foam & metal • Flatten boxes • Place loose into your Curbside Recycling Bin 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✗ Wax-coated cardboard ✗ Foil-lined cardboard ✗ Food or liquid soaked cardboard
